How to find low-cost health care in Caledonia County

1. Read about the hospitals and health clinics and their financial assistance policies.

- If you are looking at this online: Click on the blue links to learn more.
- If you are looking at this on paper: Call the hospital or health clinic and ask them to mail you the plain language summary of their financial assistance policy and an application.

2. Call the hospital or health clinic if you have questions.

- Example: Are you accepting new patients?
- Example: Do you think I might qualify for financial assistance? (Be ready to tell them your income and household size.)

3. Fill out an application and send it to the hospital or health clinic.

Eligibility

- Free Care: You may qualify for free care (pay \$0) if your income is under <u>250% of the</u> Federal Poverty Level (FPL).
- **Low-Cost Care:** You may qualify for up to a 70% discount if your household income is below 400% FPL.
- Resources: The hospital may deny your application if your household's total liquid resources are more than <u>400% FPL</u> for your household size. Liquid resources are things like cash and money in savings and checking accounts. (Your main home and cars and money held in retirement accounts will **not** count against you.)
